What is a Knowledge Transfer Partnership (KTP)?

A KTP is a funded three-way partnership between your business, one of our academics and a recent highly qualified graduate. Your designated academic partner will apply their expertise to develop an innovative solution to your business challenge. They will also recruit a suitable graduate, known as an Associate, who will work for you to implement the solution. A KTP is partfunded by a grant to support a collaboration for 12-36 months, depending on the project and the needs of your business.

What a KTP can offer you?

With a KTP, your business can improve its competitiveness, productivity and performance. You can also achieve an increase in profits, investment in plant and machinery, new jobs, staff training, as well as maintaining a sustainable culture of innovation.
