GEMS Scholarship 2024/25 (the "Scholarship")

Key Facts Document

This Key Facts Document sets out the main details of the Scholarship, as at date of publication. This document should be reviewed alongside the <u>University of Dundee Scholarship Terms and Conditions</u>, as those terms and conditions will provide you with additional information that apply to you in respect of the Scholarship.

Date of publication	October 2023, applicable to 2024/5 academic year (September 2024 or January 2025 entry).
Application Process	Automatic award
	There is no separate application form for the Scholarship.
	1. Your eligibility will be assessed by our Undergraduate Admissions team and the Scholarship is awarded as fee discount where applicable.
	2. We use information detailed on an applicant's course application to determine if they meet the eligibility criteria for this award.
	3. Please note that a change of name, misspelling, or other changes in information can affect Admissions records and may mean that you will not receive scholarship updates.
	4. Please note that the eligibility is assessed at the time of the application and will not be reevaluated post matriculation.
Who is eligible?	Have an offer to study a full-time, on campus undergraduate course of 120 credits per year in any school at the University of Dundee for September 2024 (excluding School of Medicine and School of Dentistry).
	2. Have applied to a course which has an associated full time tuition fee of £20,600 per year or above.
	3. Be starting your course in September 2024.
	4. Hold 'International' Fee Status.
Award Information	The value of the scholarship is £6,000 per year (up to a maximum of 5 years) and is awarded as a tuition fee waiver.
Key Information	The University of Dundee GEMS Scholarship is awarded to students studying at a GEMS Education Schools whilst applying to an Undergraduate course at the University of Dundee.
	2. It is not possible to be awarded this scholarship alongside Vice Chancellor's Scholarship, the Global Citizenship Scholarship or the Global Excellence Scholarship.



- 3. Awardees can receive only one of the above scholarships at any one time.
- 4. If the applicant has applied for a Part Time or Distance Learning programme, then they are **not** eligible for this scholarship.
- 5. For applicants with a fully funded external scholarship, which covers the full amount of tuition fees due to the University, then we cannot allocate this scholarship as the total combined of both awards will exceed the tuition fee total.
- 6. If an applicant has an externally funded scholarship that covers part of the full tuition fee, this can be awarded alongside one or more University of Dundee scholarships (provided that the total of the awards combined does not exceed the total UoD tuition fee).
- 7. The University reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship immediately and without notice where the student is determined by the University to have misled the University about any aspect of eligibility to receive the scholarship.
- 8. If the student withdraws from the programme, they must notify the Registry Team that they are no longer enrolled at the University of Dundee.
- 9. The University of Dundee will not back-date any awards, and all awards made will be current and apply to the student post matriculation only.
