You must have either a conditional or unconditional offer to study an Undergraduate programme in any of the University of Dundee’s Academic Schools in September 2024. 2. Be Indian domiciled. 3. Be starting your course in September 2024. 4. Have been awarded Vice Chancellor’s South Asia scholarship OR Global Excellence Scholarship. 5. Hold 'International' Fee Status.



Award Information	<ul style="list-style-type: none">The winner of the scholarship will receive a single payment of an additional £5,000 on top of the Vice Chancellor's South Asia scholarship OR Global Excellence Scholarship
Key Information	<ol style="list-style-type: none">This scholarship which will be awarded to an Indian domiciled student who wishes to study for an undergraduate degree in any subject starting in September 2024.To be eligible, you must already have been awarded the University of Dundee Global Excellence Scholarship or Vice Chancellor's South Asia scholarship.The programme must be a 12-month, full time programme. If the programme is less than 12 months then the applicant is not eligible for the scholarship.If the applicant has applied for a Part Time or Distance Learning programme, then they are not eligible for this scholarship.For applicants with a fully funded external scholarship, which covers the full amount of tuition fees due to the University, then we cannot allocate this scholarship as the total combined of both awards will exceed the tuition fee total.If an applicant has an externally funded scholarship that covers part of the full tuition fee, this can be awarded alongside one or more University of Dundee scholarships (provided that the total of the awards combined does not exceed the total UoD tuition fee).The University reserves the right to withdraw the scholarship immediately and without notice where the student is determined by the University to have misled the University about any aspect of eligibility to receive the scholarship.If the student withdraws from the programme, they must notify the Registry Team that they are no longer enrolled at the University of Dundee.The University of Dundee will not back-date any awards, and all awards made will be current and apply to the student post matriculation only.
