Who is eligible?	All applicants must:
	1. Apply during 2024 Clearing
	2. Hold an offer to study an eligible Undergraduate course at the University of Dundee:
	<ul> <li>Undergraduate – Must hold an offer for a full time, on campus course – this excludes any course in the School of Medicine or Dentistry.</li> </ul>
	UG course must be 120 credits.
	3. Be classified as an International Fee-paying student by the University of Dundee.
	4. Have a Course tuition fee of £20,600.
	NB: Any course which does not have a fee of this value, or above, will not be considered for this award.



## Scholarship Information

- 1. The value of this scholarship is £3,000 and is awarded as a tuition fee waiver. No direct payment is made to any applicant.
- 2. The scholarship is paid in each year of applicable study:
  - Undergraduate applicants can receive a scholarship for up to 5 years of progressing study. (£15,000 over 5 years).
- 3. Scholarships are awarded on an Unconditional basis. However, this is not linked to the Course application status.
- 4. Scholarships cannot be awarded on a pro-rata basis.

## **Key Information**

- 1. This scholarship is applicable in the entry year to the University of Dundee only and cannot be backdated to previous years.
- 2. The University will not offer a scholarship to students who have matriculated at the University in their chosen programme of study.
- 3. Applicants are unable to combine the Discover Clearing scholarship with:
  - Any other University of Dundee scholarship
  - If an applicant has an externally funded scholarship that covers part of the full tuition fee, this can be awarded alongside one or more University of Dundee scholarships (provided that the total of the awards combined does not exceed the total UoD tuition fee).
  - If the applicant holds a fully funded external scholarship, the Discover Clearing Scholarship will be removed as all tuition fees will be covered. The University will not provide the Discover Clearing Scholarship as an additional award.
- 4. Should an applicant wish to defer their entry to the University of Dundee, the following rule applies:
  - Deferral within the same academic year: Scholarship can also be deferred.
  - Deferral to a new academic year: Scholarship cannot be deferred.
- 5. If an applicant changes Course before, during or after matriculation, the University reserves the right to re-assess eligibility for scholarships and may retract the Scholarship Offer should an applicant's eligibility have changed.
- 6. If an applicant changes Fee status or any other personal information before, during or after matriculation, the University reserves the right to re-assess eligibility for scholarships and may retract the Scholarship Offer should an applicant's eligibility have changed.



- 7. If an applicant has paid their tuition fees in full prior to being awarded the Discover Clearing, the value of the scholarship will be refunded to the applicant after they have enrolled at the University of Dundee.
- 8. Alternatively, this can be transferred to the University accommodation account balance (if applicable).
- 9. The scholarship is only paid to applicants in the years in which full tuition fees are paid. This applies to applicant who may study abroad during their Undergraduate studies.
- 10. The University of Dundee fees department will confirm the status of the scholarship where required.
- 11. All communication with the student will be via email, and to the @dundee.ac.uk email address. We may also communicate with other email addresses provided to us by the applicant. Types of communication may be:
  - Confirming the scholarship;
  - Informing the applicant that they have not met the criteria to be awarded the scholarship.
  - Requesting further information.
- 12. We are unable to disclose details of the scholarship to anyone other than the applicant unless consent is given to do so.
- 13. Should a student withdraw from programme of study, the University Fees

  Department may be in contact regarding payment of fees and scholarship balance.
- 14. All scholarship decisions are final and cannot be appealed.
